



# SCRIP @ TKA

## What is Scrip?

Scrip is gift certificates/cards that are just like cash. It can be used for things like groceries and gas, gifts, dining, entertainment, and home improvements.  
A percentage of each of your purchases is given to TKA.

## How does Scrip work?

TKA purchases scrip through the Great Lakes Scrip Company and local grocery stores at reduced rates. You pay TKA the face value of the gift card and use it to make your purchases.

**It costs you nothing.** For every dollar spent using scrip TKA receives 1.5 % - 18% as a donation from the retailer. We need it! Revenue generated helps TKA in many ways.

## How do I order and pay for Scrip?

**Scrip participation requires only a little planning.** Go to [www.shopwithscrip.com](http://www.shopwithscrip.com) and set up your account using TKA's enrollment code: D877DB775133.

Designate TKA as your non-profit.

**Place your order on-line:** Print out your order.

Make payment to TKA with your check, cash or credit card information.

Once your order is paid for it will be included in TKA's monthly order.

You will be notified of a convenient pick-up date.
